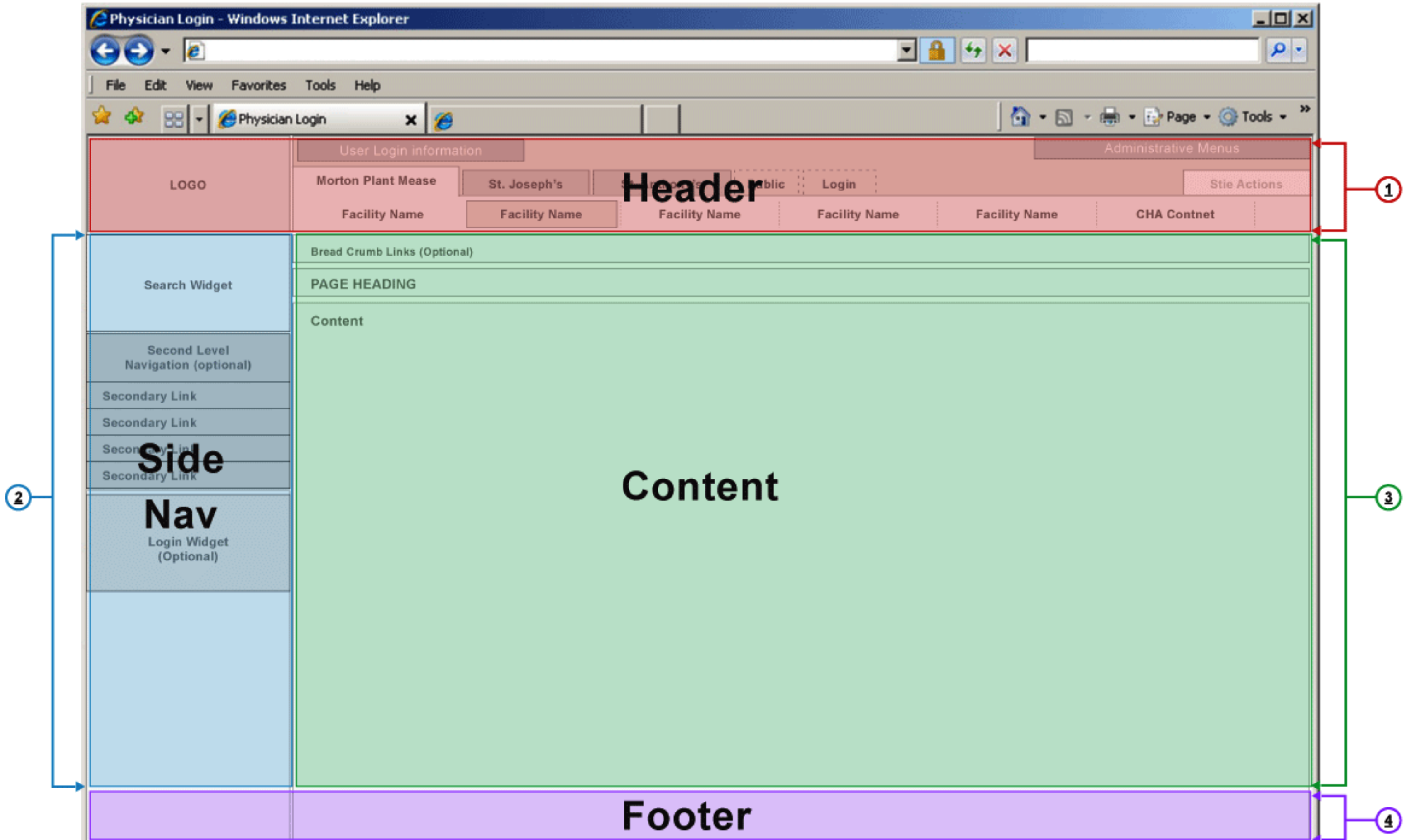

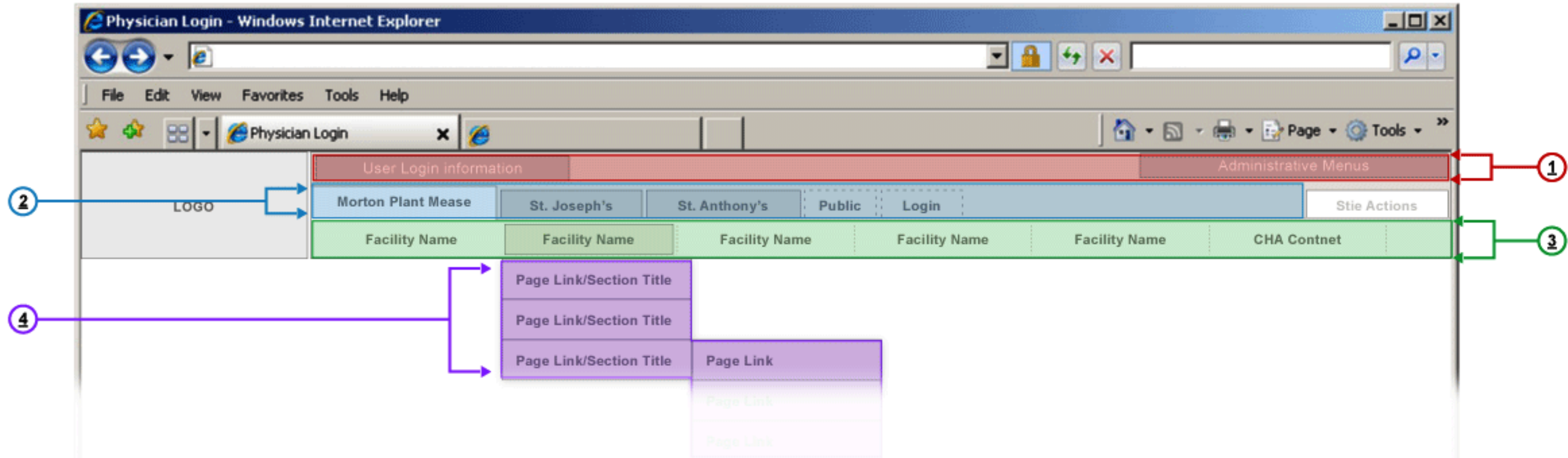

 These link tabs will contain CHA selection as well as any public (non-register user) info, an or register (logged in, registered user) info. Two tabs are displayed to represent the separation of content. This can be changed if desired.

- 3 First/Facility Level Links**  
 Administrative and login information not related to content.

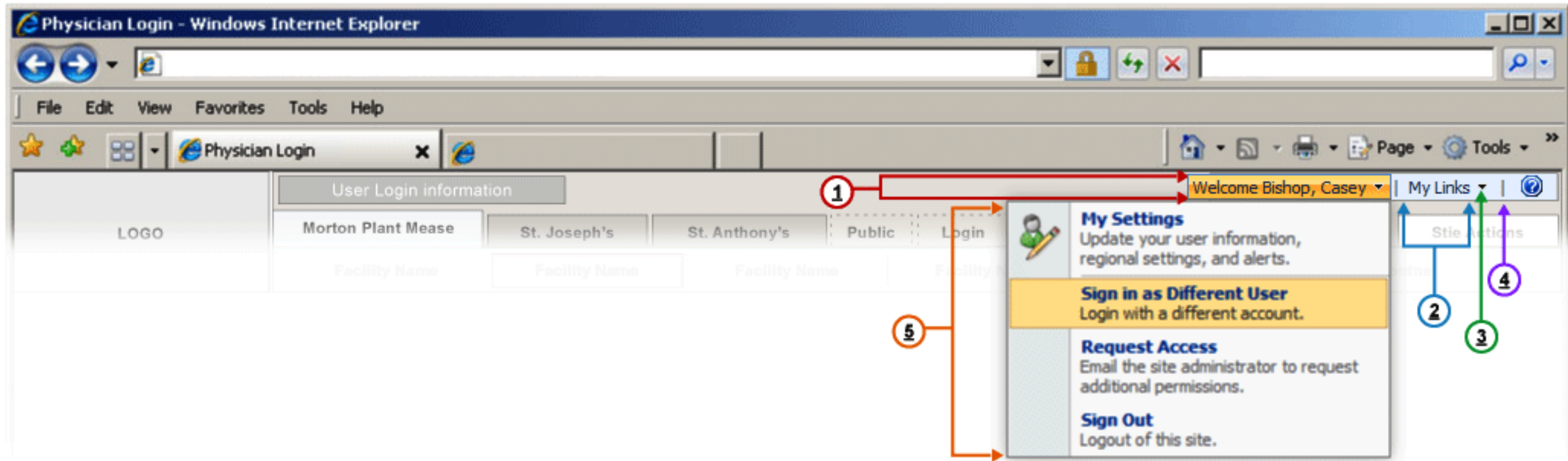

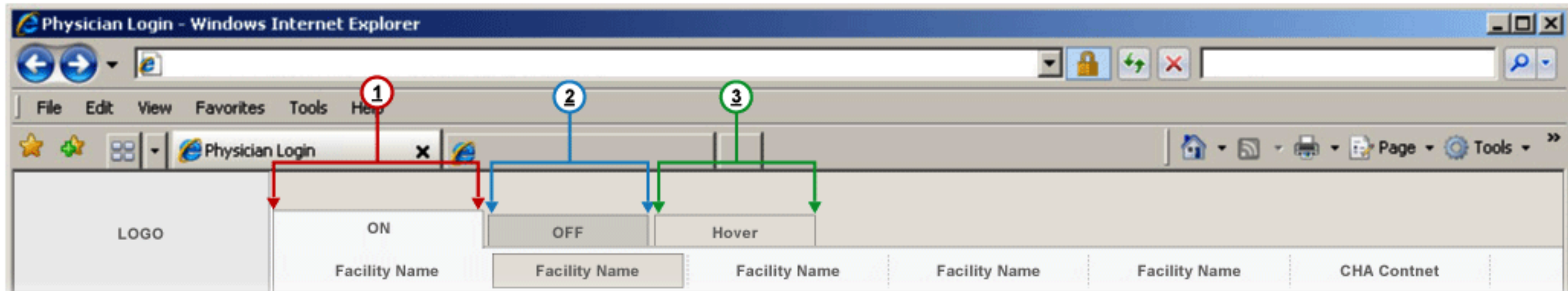

## Physician Portal - Top Level Navigation States

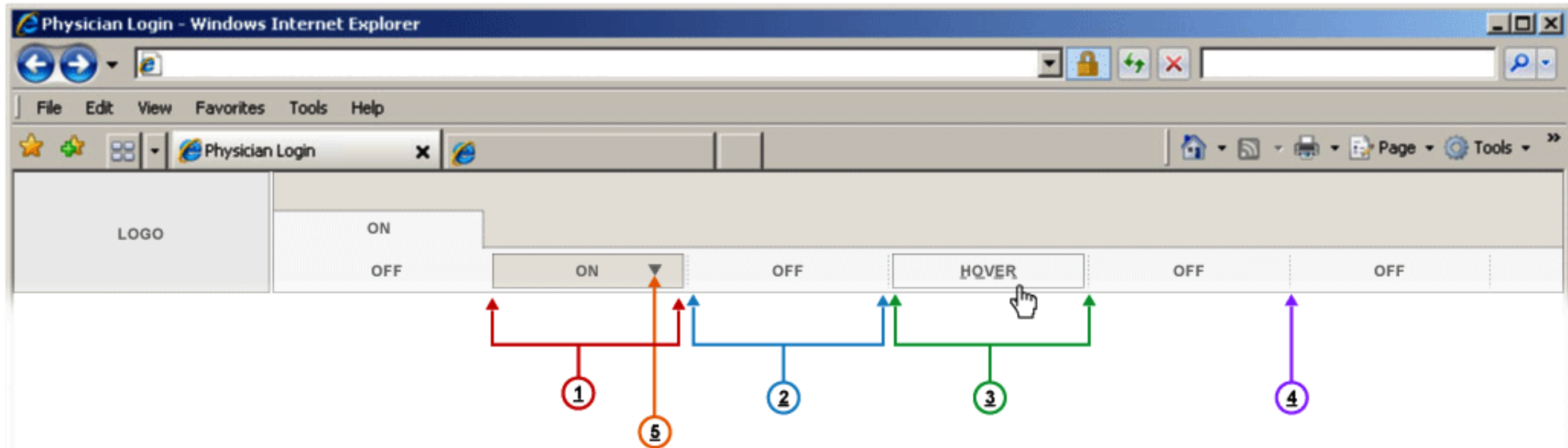


**1 On State**  
On state will need to be visually different than the other "off" states. On state must visually contain it's first level links. These will maintain the CHA/Facility relationship.

**2 Off State**  
Should be visually secondary to "On" state.

**3 Hover State**  
Hover state will need change the look of the tab when the user rolls over or hovers over the area with their mouse.

## Physician Portal - First Level Navigation States



**1 On State**  
A status indicator marking that the user is within this section of the site. This could be done by background image or color or the addition of a image etc...

**2 Off State**  
Should be visually different from the on state.

**3 Hover State**  
Hover state will need change the look of the link when the user rolls over or hovers over the area with their mouse.

**4 Link Separator**  
An image, border or text character (i.e. | or ::) that visually separates link areas from one another.

**5 Additional Links Icon**  
Icon is used to indicate additional links that maybe displayed when the user hovers over the link area.

## Physician Portal - Header Navigation 2nd - 3rd Lvl Drop Down Menus


**1 Off State**  
Should be visibly different than the hover states. If containing child links an additional links icon should appear indicated more options.

**2 ON Hover**  
When a link section has additional child links within it the user can hover over the link, visibly changing the appearance, and open up a third level navigation menu.

**3 ON State**  
link visibly changes indicating the user's mouse is over the link area and is click able.

**4 Additional Links Icon**  
Icon is used to indicate additional links that maybe displayed when the user hovers over the link area.

1 **Side Navigation**

This area will provide the user with secondary and tertiary links under the Facility or CHA levels. It may also contain functional widgets such as search physicians, search my patients, and login section. These elements will display or not display based on where the user is currently on the site and their login status.

The navigation portion of this section could have Higher level link categories titles with links grouped and listed below the category title (i.e. Link Category Title = "My Apps", Link = "App Name", Link = "App Name", Link = "App Name" etc....)

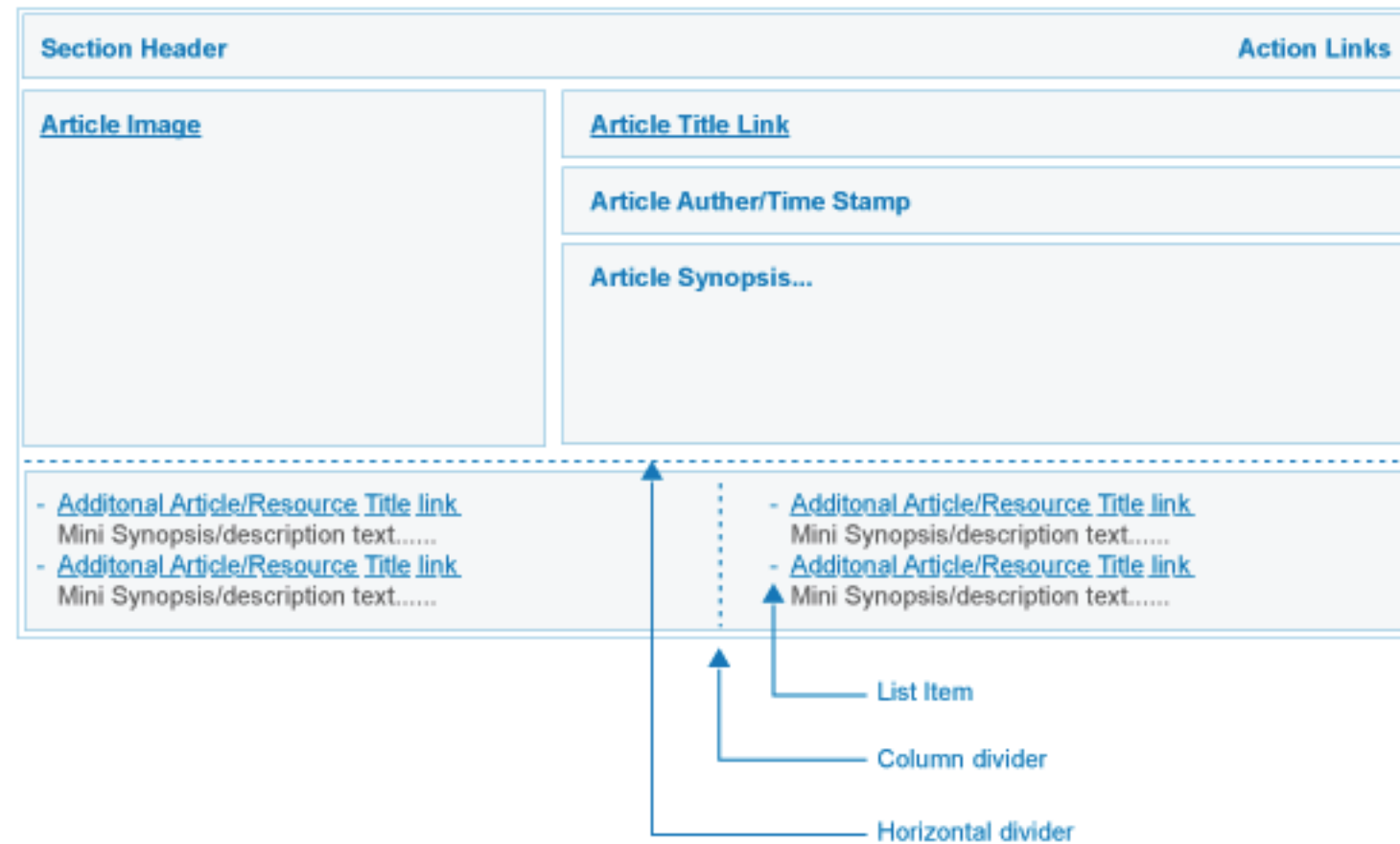
